EXPERIMENT KIT LIST

To help you prepare for the experiments in the next issue of Whizz Pop Bang, we've compiled a list of things you'll need to ensure your child is ready for the science activities as soon as the magazine drops through the letterbox! Just to let you know, we haven't included the basic items such as scissors, paper etc.

WILL IT FLOAT? (page 7)

- A collection of objects, for example: oranges, sticky tack or modelling clay

MAKE YOUR OWN ICEBERG (page 9)

- A cup or bag of water, frozen
- A whiteboard pen, sticker or sticky tack

WHAT MAKES IRON AND STEEL RUST? (page 11)

- Three sealable containers (e.g. jam jars)
- Three identical iron nails (not galvanised)
- Water that has been boiled and cooled
- Vegetable oil

PADDLE BOAT (page 16)

- A clean plastic food tray (ideally black)
- Another piece of plastic packaging (ideally black)
- Five elastic bands
- Two pencils
- Sticky tack
- A scrap of plastic bag at least 9 cm by 12 cm
- A paper straw

MAKE YOUR OWN MINI HOVERCRAFT (page 25)

- Sticky tack or modelling clay
- Pull up drinks bottle top
- An old CD
- A balloon
