MAKE A PARACHUTE (page 7)

- ☐ An old handkerchief or similar-sized piece of fabric or soft plastic packaging
- ☐ String
- ☐ A hole punch
- ☐ Two small toy figures or dolls of the same weight

FLY AN AEROFOIL (page 9)

- ☐ A piece of card 8 cm x 9 cm
- ☐ A stapler
- ☐ A hairdryer

BAT BANNER (page 16)

- ☐ Cardboard tubes from loo roll or kitchen towel
- ☐ A serrated knife
- ☐ A drawing pin
- ☐ Pipecleaners (2-3 per bat)
- ☐ Thick paper or thin card (white, brown, black and/or grey)
- ☐ Paint or felt tips (black, brown, grey and/or orange) and brushes
- ☐ An old black or grey plastic bag
- ☐ Sticky tack
- ☐ String or wool measuring 2 m

- ☐ Sticky tack

STRAW PLANES (page 19)

- ☐ Paper straws
