



MAKE A CHRISTMAS GIFT BOX

Make this easy gift box – ideal for wrapping sweet treats for friends and family!

You will need:

- Scissors
- Ribbon
- Hole punch

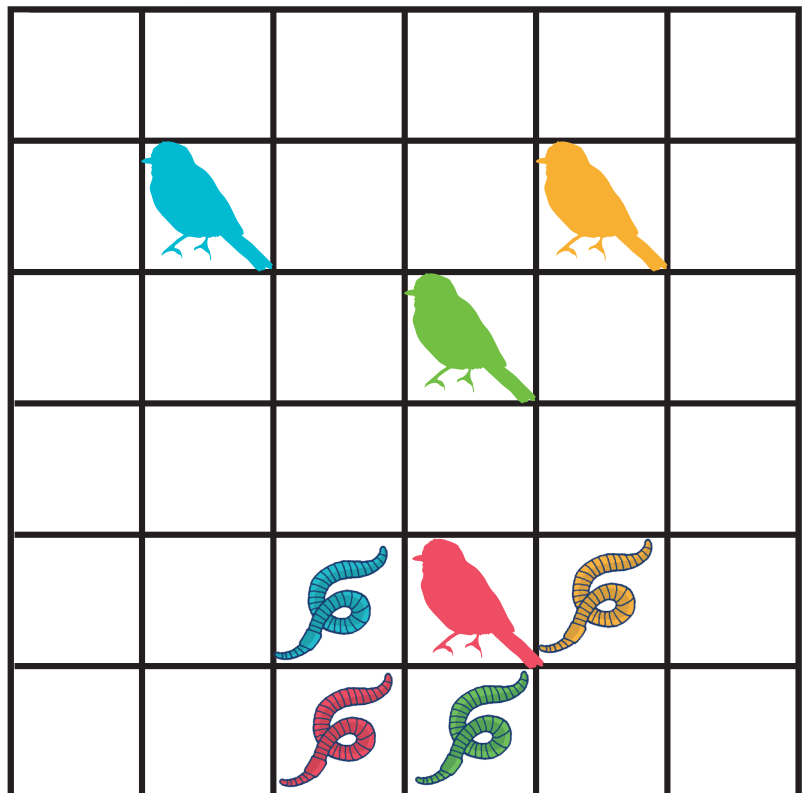
What you do...

1. Print the following two pages onto two sheets of paper. Paste the back of one sheet with glue, hold it up to the light, against a window, and stick the other sheet on top so that the outlines are aligned.
2. Cut out the gift box and gift tag template. Fold the gift tag and punch a hole through the circle.
3. Gently curve the two star sides of the gift box so that the stars meet at the centre.
4. Thread both stars first through one slot and then through the other.
5. Use a piece of ribbon to tie the gift tag around the top.
